

Electricity Regulatory Authority: Classes of Information

A Class of Information is a method of collecting together similar types of information. The Electricity Regulatory Authority (ERA) has grouped its Classes of Information into broad categories by function, reflecting the major areas of responsibility for the Authority. The major areas of responsibility include operational and administrative functions.

Operational Functions

1. Licensing of Electricity Generation, Transmission and Distribution
