Grand Cayman

Condition 32 in the Caribbean Utilities Company, Ltd. (CUC) Electricity Transmission and Distribution (T&D) Licence discusses the encouragement of renewable generation on Grand Cayman.¹

A renewables-only solicitation can be conducted by either the ERA or CUC, independently. If conducted by the ERA, a competitive solicitation similar to the process outlined in Condition 31 of the T&D Licence will take place. If conducted by CUC, the ERA will only become involved in the process once a final power purchase agreement has been submitted for approval.

*An independent power producer (IPP) may also submit an unsolicited proposal at any time to CUC for consideration. The ERA should be notified of any unsolicited proposal to CUC by the IPP.
